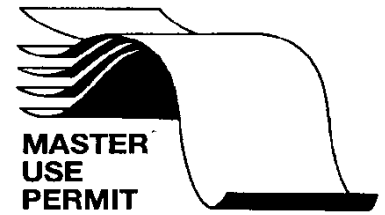

PROCESS

A Design Review application for future development of this site has been submitted to the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (Seattle DCI). The first phase of Design Review includes the (EDG) meeting. The following occurs at the meeting:

1. Presentation by the applicant about the site, vicinity and early massing design concepts.
2. Comments by the public regarding the design of the new development.*
3. Deliberation by the Design Review Board providing design guidance and identifying significant Design Guidelines applicable to the design as it moves forward towards Master Use Permit (MUP) application.

***Please note that public comment at this meeting is limited to design considerations.** (If environmental review is triggered, comments related to environmental impacts, such as traffic, parking, noise, etc. may be sent to Seattle DCI following notice of that review.)
