Your Comments: I attended this meeting & left feeling patronized. I wrote to you requesting this meeting. In my letter I posed questions about the infrastructure, specifically water/sewage capacity of the "new" line & storage tanks put in our neighborhood, in response to one death & a class action payment to neighbors who had to suffer the effects of 3 floods in their residences. I asked that these questions be answered but never received a response. The city paid out one million dollars for this suit. That is taxpayer money being

to residents who had repeatedly appealed to the city to solve this problem. I find the resolution portrays the city as uninterested in public appeals and fiscally irresponsible with taxpayer funds.

Please be frank & address the questions posed in my letter. You have already rubber stamped this project by moving it forward to this phase. You continue to appear to be open to public comment & yet I feel this is more political than you are not acting on what you hear or thoroughly investigating the proposed site.

I expect a response with this letter. I expect to see more knowledgeable response to our questions by hearing information that you actually saw the site & are considering its impact on the existing neighborhood.
