**AMENDED SECOND
PREHEARING
ORDER**

2. Parties opening statements and closing arguments shall be in the following order:

- (1) Department;
- (2) Applicant (WSDOT); and
- (3) Appellants:
 - a. HC-18-002;
 - b. HC-18-005;
 - c. HC-18-003;
 - d. HC-18-004;
 - e. HC-18-006.

3. The order of presentation of evidence by Appellants shall be as follows:
 - a. HC-18-002;
 - b. HC-18-005;
 - c. HC-18-003;
 - d. HC-18-004;
 - e. HC-18-006.
4. If an appellant listed no witnesses, only the party representative may testify.
5. To avoid repetitive statements, presentation of evidence, and argument, parties are encouraged to join with others on some or all of issues. Please note that you may only join statements, testimony or argument presented on those issues you included in your appeal notice.
