**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF A SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS) FOR  
PROPOSED LAND USE CODE AMENDMENTS RELATED TO THE TREE REGULATIONS**

The Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI) has withdrawn the DNS that was issued for proposed Land Use Code amendments related to the tree regulations and that was noticed in the City's Land Use Information Bulletin on August 23, 2018. SDCI expects to issue a new SEPA threshold determination for proposed updated amendments to the tree regulations and that threshold determination will identify a new appeal period for potential appeals of that determination to the Seattle Hearings Examiner.
