7	When SEPA applies to a decision, any judicial appeal of that decision potentially involves both those issues pertaining to SEPA (SEPA
8	issues) and those which do not (non-SEPA issues). RCW 43.21C.075 establishes time limits for raising SEPA issues, but says that existing
9	statutes of limitations control the appeal of non-SEPA issues. The statute contemplates a single lawsuit. If there is a time limit established by statute or ordinance for appealing the underlying governmental
10	
11	action, then appeals (or portions thereof) raising SEPA issues must be filed within such time period.
12	WAC 197-11-680. Appellants request that the Examiner clarify the Decision to state that an appeal
13 14	of the Decision must be filed within the same time period for appealing the underlying governmental
15	action per state law.
