

**ORDER ON MOTION FOR
RECONSIDERATION**

The Respondent in the above noted matters, the City of Seattle ("City"), has filed a motion for reconsideration seeking a correction to the postscript to the Findings, Conclusions and Decision issued on November 21, 2018. The Appellants have joined the City in its motion. The motion notes that the postscript concerning appeals is not applicable for a non-project EIS appeal, such as the subject of these appeals.

The City's Motion for Reconsideration is **GRANTED**. HER 3.18 requires that the Hearing Examiner's decision include a postscript concerning subsequent procedural steps for appealing the Hearing Examiner's decision. Therefore, a revised Findings, Conclusions, and Decision will be issued with a corrected postscript.
