**PREHEARING
ORDER**

On December 19, 2018, a pre-hearing conference was held regarding this matter. Represented at the conference were the Appellants, Seattle for Growth, by Roger Valdez, and Seattle Mobility Coalition by Courtney Kaylor attorney-at-law (collectively herein "Appellants"). The City of Seattle ("City"), was represented by Elizabeth Anderson, attorney-at-law.

During the prehearing conference the parties discussed a briefing schedule for pre-hearing motions, identified a schedule for final witness and exhibit lists and exchange of exhibits, and a hearing schedule. The following matters were discussed and resolved:

1. The City indicated it plans to file a pre-hearing motion. The City shall file with the Office of Hearing Examiner, and serve a copy on the other parties, its motion, no later than 5:00 PM on January 14, 2019.
2. The Appellants shall file and serve their responses to the motion, no later than 5:00 PM on January 28, 2019.
3. The City shall file and serve its reply, no later than 5:00 PM on February 4, 2019.
4. The Appellants shall file and serve their final witness lists¹ and final exhibit lists, no later than 5:00 PM on March 4, 2019. The Appellants shall serve the other parties a copy of each of the exhibits listed on their exhibit lists, no later than 5:00 PM on March 4, 2019. (Exhibits are not to be filed with the Office of the Hearing Examiner electronically or in hard copy. Parties are not required to provide copies of an exhibit to another party if the other party is known to possess a copy of the exhibit. Parties must be prepared to provide a copy of any exhibit to be introduced at the hearing in hard-copy form to the Hearing Examiner.)


¹ Witness lists must include the names of witnesses, a brief summary of their expected testimony, and an estimate of the time a witness is expected to provide direct testimony. If a witness will be testifying as an expert, a statement of qualifications must be included with the witness list. Except for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.

5. The City shall file and serve its final witness list and final exhibit list, no later than 5:00 PM on March 11, 2019. The City shall serve the other parties a copy of each of the exhibits listed on its exhibit list, no later than 5:00 PM on March 11, 2019.

The hearing in this matter is scheduled to be held on March 18, 2019, beginning at 9:00 AM in the Office of Hearing Examiner, Hearing Room 4000, 700 Fifth Avenue, (Seattle Municipal Tower, 40th Floor) Seattle, Washington. In addition to this initial hearing date, March 19 and 20 have been reserved on the hearing calendar for continuation of the hearing.

The parties are reminded that Hearing Examiner Rule (HER) 2.05(a) requires that any electronically filed document more than 10 pages in length, including exhibits, must also be delivered to the Hearing Examiner in hard copy; and HER 2.05(c) prohibits the filing of more than 15 pages with the Office of Hearing Examiner by electronic facsimile.
