DECLARATION OF WALLIS BOLZ
IN SUPPORT OF SAVE MADISON
VALLEY'S RESPONSE TO SDCI's
MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

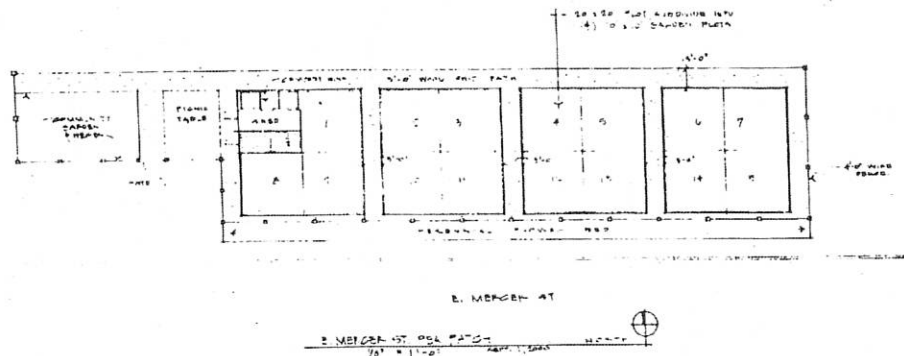
I, WALLIS BOLZ, declare as follows:

1. I previously testified in this matter about the history of the Mad P P-Patch (or "Mad P" for short), my involvement with the Mad P community since 2003, and impacts on the Mad P from Velmeir's proposal, including shadow impacts. I make this declaration based upon my own personal knowledge.

2. SDCI's motion for reconsideration opines that the western-most strip of plots within the P-Patch (which SDCI refers to as the "panhandle") are not "formally part of the existing community garden." The basis for the city's new view of this issue appears to be a Geocortex map submitted as Attachment B to SDCI's motion, which appears to omit the panhandle from its depiction of the P-Patch.

1 3. SDCI's view of this issue is false. The Panhandle is a formal part of the Mad P P-
2 Patch.

3 4. The eastern half of the current panhandle was part of the original site map for the Mad
4 P, when the P-Patch was first approved by the Department of Neighborhoods ("DON") and Seattle
5 Department of Transportation ("SDOT"). Attached hereto as **Exhibit A** is a true and correct copy of
6 the original SeaTran (now SDOT) permit for the P-Patch, together with the original site map. The
7 original site map is also excerpted below. Originally, the portion of the panhandle depicted below (on
8 the left side of the image) was used as an herb garden. As the Examiner can see, the eastern half of the
9 current panhandle was clearly part of the original site design.

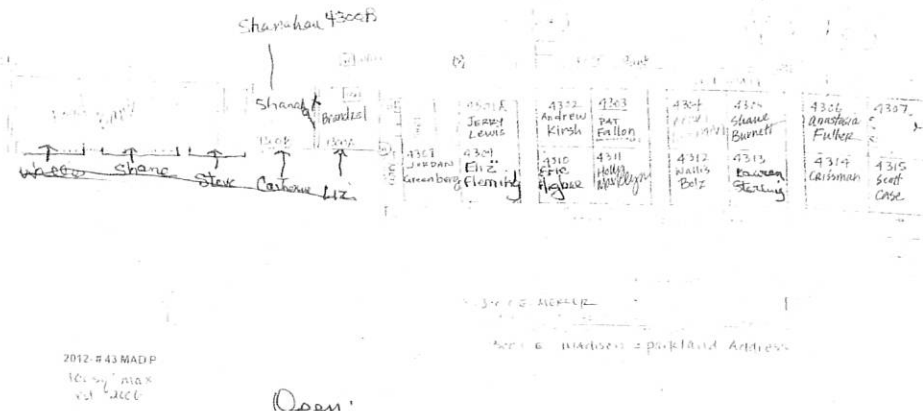

19 5. Later, the panhandle was expanded to the west for use as a Kid's Garden. In 2006, this
20 addition to the P-Patch was formally recognized by DON as part of the official P-Patch. This formal
21 recognition was communicated to the Mad P community by Sandy Pernitz of DON, who conveyed to
22 our community that DON had reached an agreement with SDOT to formally include what was then
23 the Kid's Garden within the official P-Patch.
24

25 6. Each year through 2015, Ms. Pernitz circulated a hand-drawn map of the P-Patch to
26 individuals who would be leasing plots during the coming year. Attached hereto as **Exhibit B** is a true

1 and correct copy of the map that Ms. Pernitz circulated in 2012, listing the tenant or tenants for each
2 plot. In the lower left-hand corner of Exhibit A, Ms. Pernitz wrote "est. 2006," denoting that the current
3 footprint of the P-Patch (including the western-most portion of the panhandle) was formally approved
4 in 2006. This annotation was included in each prior iteration of the map since 2006. However, in the
5 time I have had since SDCI filed its motion for reconsideration, I have not been able to locate those
6 older maps.
7

8 7. Below is an excerpt from Exhibit B showing the footprint of the P-Patch as of 2012,
9 including Ms. Pernitz's notation that it was approved in 2006. The area marked "food bank" at the
10 west end of the panhandle is what I am referring to as the Kid's Garden. By this time, the herb garden
11 in the eastern half of the panhandle had also been converted to two individual plots (identified as plots
12 4300A and 4300B in the image below).

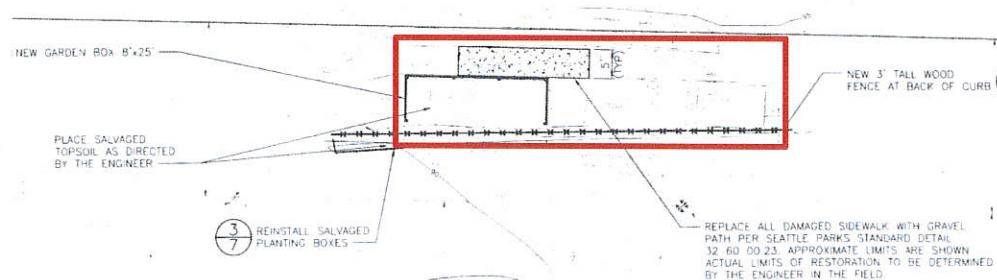

22 8. The configuration of the panhandle changed somewhat in 2015. Two years prior, in
23 2013, there was a break in a sewer line in the hill above the Mad P P-Patch, in the Mercer-Madison
24 Woods. Representatives from Seattle Public Utilities ("SPU") met with Sandy Pernitz and I as the fix
25 would require the use of a portion of the Mad P to access the hillside. We worked with SPU and
26

1 created a plan/schedule for repairing the pipe and restoration of the P-Patch following the fix. Work
2 was to begin in November of 2014.

3
4 9. In August of 2014, however, I noted a bubble of sewage plus a strong sewage smell
5 down by the Kid's Garden, which was located at that time in the panhandle. Following my reporting
6 of that event, SPU expedited the repair. King County also closed the panhandle plots due to concerns
7 about contamination.

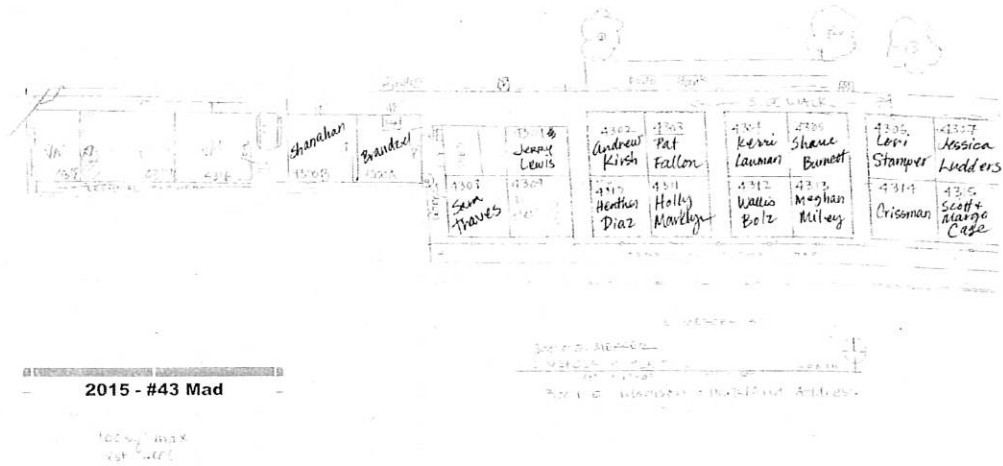
8 10. Ultimately, SPU reconstructed the panhandle plots in 2015, at the city's expense.
9 Attached hereto as **Exhibit C** is a true and correct copy of the final restoration plan, which I obtained
10 from Scott Stevens, P.E., who was a senior capital projects coordinator at SPU. The restoration plan
11 depicts the work that was done by the city to restore the panhandle plots after the sewage leak. The
12 project involved construction of a new 8' x 25' garden box (to contain the soil outside the right-of-
13 way), replacement of a damaged P-Patch walkway, a new fence, and reinstallation of salvaged planting
14 boxes. Below is an excerpt from SPU's restoration plan, depicting the work that was done. The red
15 box, which I have added, shows the location of the panhandle.

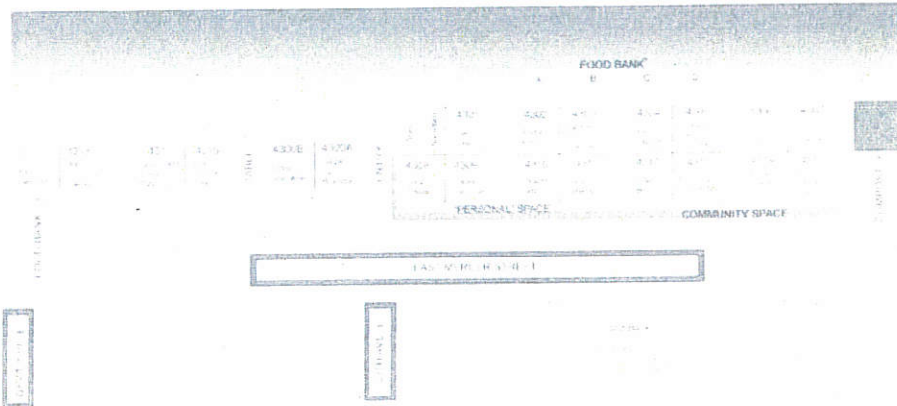
23 11. Around the time of the sewage leak, the Mad P community decided that it would be
24 better to convert the Kid's Garden to individual plots. Ultimately, that work was carried out by SPU
25 as part of its 2015 restoration project. Attached hereto as **Exhibit D** is a true and correct copy of the
26 annual map that Ms. Pernitz sent out in 2015, depicting the new plots at the west end of the Panhandle

1 that SPU created (plots 4316, 4317, and 4318), and the individuals leasing the plots that year. The
 2 2015 map is also reproduced below. As above, Ms. Pernitz's notation that the footprint was approved
 3 in 2006 can be seen in lower left-hand corner ("est. 2006").

12. Ms. Pernitz was the Mad P P-Patch coordinator with DON until around April of 2015,
 when she was replaced in that role by Lisa Uemoto, another DON employee. In subsequent years, Ms.
 Uemoto continued Ms. Pernitz's tradition of circulating a map of the Mad P P-Patch each spring,
 listing the names of people who would be leasing plots for the coming year. Attached hereto as **Exhibit**
E is a true and correct copy of the map that Ms. Uemoto circulated in 2016. As before, the western-
 most "panhandle" plots are depicted as a formal part of the P-Patch. Below is an excerpt from the P-
 Patch map created by Ms. Uemoto in 2016, and circulated to the Mad P community.





13. Finally, DON has been leasing the individual panhandle plots for as long as they have existed. **Exhibit F** contains true and correct copies of applications from six individuals to rent four of the panhandle plots in 2019 — these are plots 4300A, 4316, 4317, and 4318. I obtained these applications from the named individuals but redacted their addresses. As the Examiner can see, five of these individuals are the same people who rented these plots over the past several years — Gene and Liz Brandzel (Plot 4300A), Paula Ladd and Hunter Robbins (4317), and Alexandria Jaeger (Plot 4318).

14. I do not know how SDCI created the Geocortex map submitted as Exhibit B to its motion for reconsideration, showing that the panhandle plots are not part of the P-Patch. But based on everything I know about the history of the Mad P P-Patch, that map is wrong.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct.

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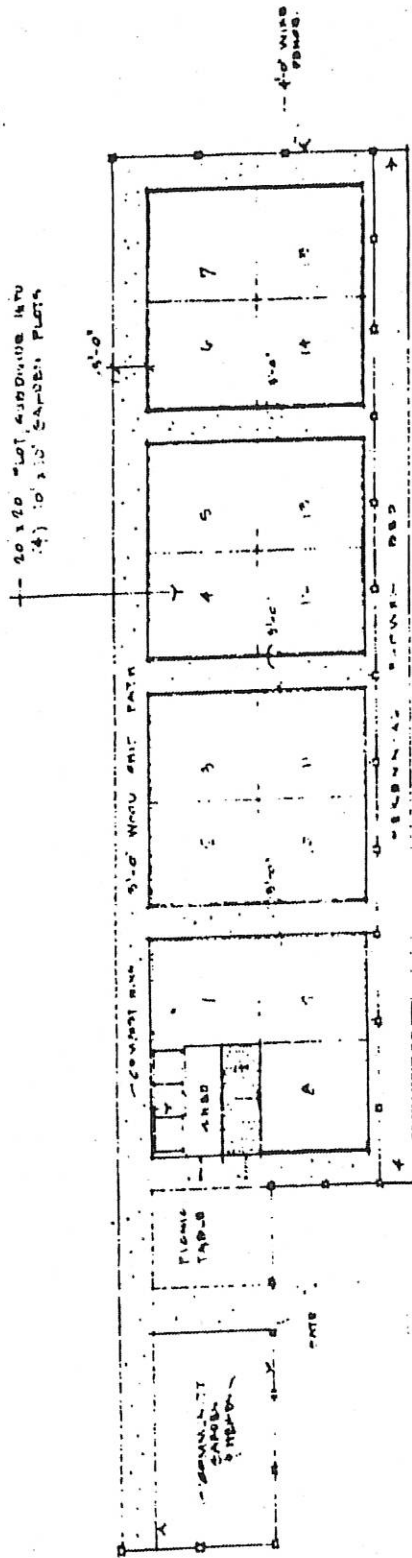

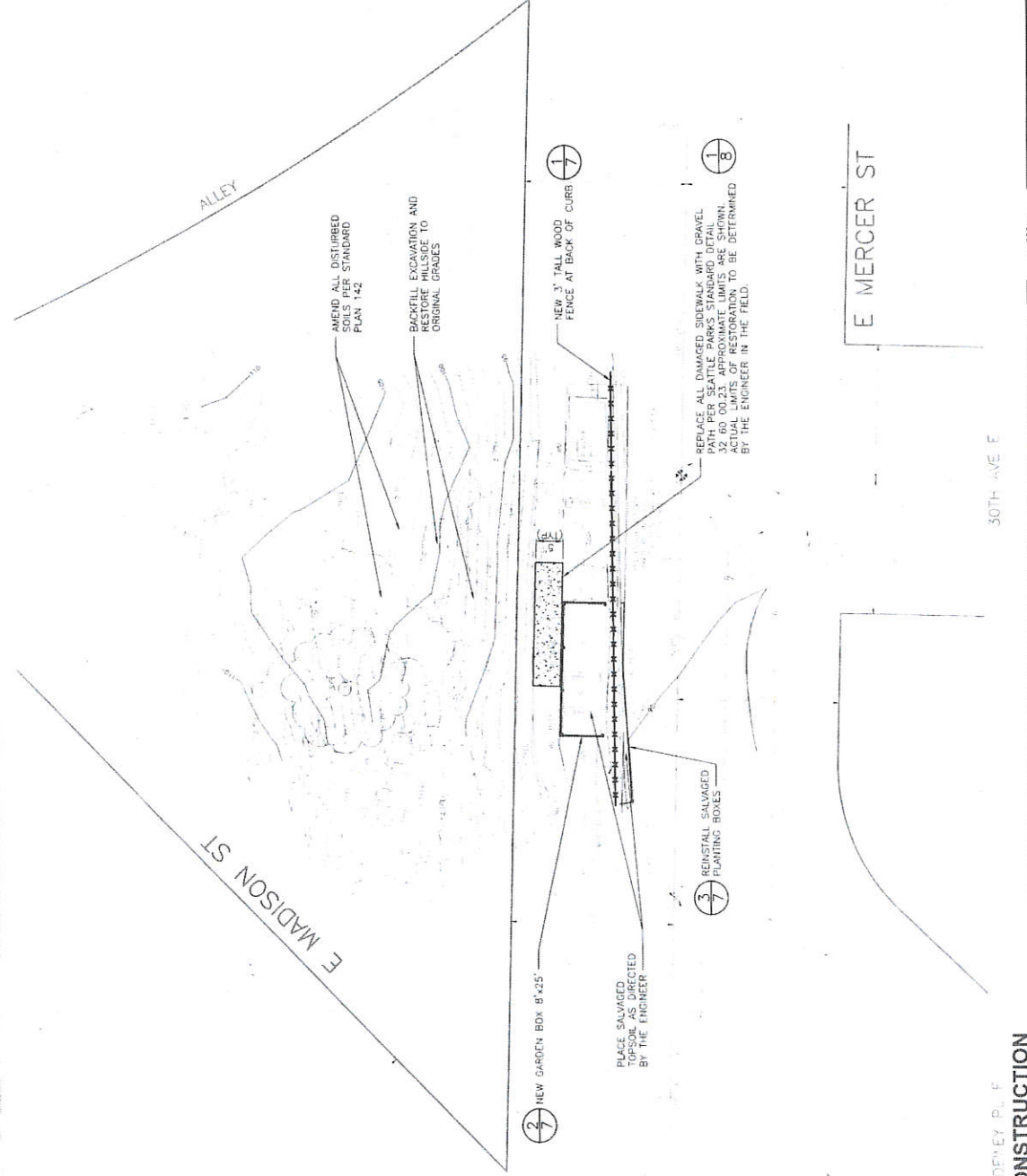

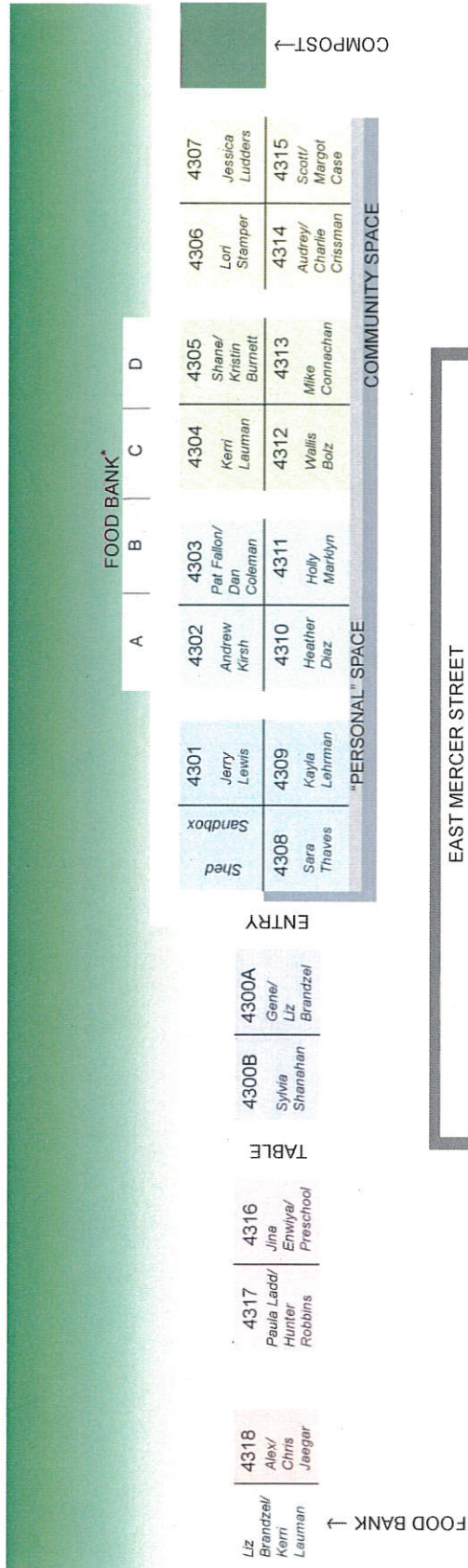
