**ORDER ON MOTION TO  
SUPPLEMENT RECORD**

On February 14, 2020, Cornelia Dude ("Objector") filed a Motion to Supplement Record of Hearing<sup>1</sup>. No response was filed opposing the motion.

The hearing for CWF-0017 has been consolidated into a single hearing, with several hundred other objections filed, concerning the Waterfront LID Assessment. Each objector has been provided an opportunity to file materials with their objection, and to appear at hearing to testify and submit additional materials. Each objector has been provided the time requested to present their objection. At the conclusion of an objector's presentation for that objector's case, the record for that case is closed, and no additional materials or testimony may be submitted for that case except by request by motion of the objector, and by approval of the motion/request by the Hearing Examiner.

The motion requests the opportunity to submit proof of the "2013 beginning of demolition/construction in the vicinity of" the Objector's residential parcel, that was referenced in the Objector's testimony. In this case, the Objector seeks to supplement the record for her case, with a single document that is related to an issue raised during her testimony. The material is non-duplicative of material already submitted by the Objector, and of materials submitted by other objectors. In addition, the impact on the hearing schedule, record, hearing examiner resources, and other objectors is limited.

The Motion to Supplement Record of Hearing for Case No. CWF-0017 is **GRANTED**.
