To be admitted, evidence must be relevant, come from a reliable source, and have some value toward proving the point of the party who offers it. If a party intends to refer to any exhibits (documents, photographs, etc.) at the hearing, the party <u>must</u> bring copies of the exhibits for the other parties and for the Hearing Examiner.
