MOTION TO AMEND APPEAL

This is an appeal of a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) issued by the Seattle City Council (“City”) related to Mobile Home Park Legislation proposed by the City. Yacov Sinai o/b/o Bella Bee, LLC (“Appellant”) filed this appeal on May 17, 2021.

On August 5, 2021, the City issued a re-notice of the DNS (“Re-notice”) that did not include any changes to the proposed legislation or substantive changes to the SEPA analysis. Appellant respectfully requests that the Hearing Examiner amend this appeal to clarify that it includes the Re-notice in addition to the original DNS.

Hearing Examiner Rule of Practice and Procedure (“HER”) 3.05 provides: “For good cause shown, the Hearing Examiner may allow an appeal to be amended no later than 10 days

1 after the date on which it was filed. In deciding whether to allow such an amendment, the
2 Hearing Examiner shall consider whether the fair hearing opportunity of other parties would be
3 prejudiced by the amendment.” It was not possible to file this request for amendment within ten
4 days of the filing of the appeal, because the Re-notice had not yet been issued. Because the text
5 of the legislation and substance of the appeal are unchanged, no party will be prejudiced by
6 allowing this amendment.
