The Determination wrongly holds Newway jointly and severally liable for damages and penalties Interest:

asserted therein, totaling \$2,225,990.30, despite this being Newway's first alleged wage violation. This assessment is based on an incorrect finding that Newway was a joint employer with its

subcontractor Baja Concrete USA Corp. and its employee Roberto Contreras.

Newway did not jointly employ any Baja employees; OLS has only identified eight employees yet seeks damages and penalties for 52 employees; OLS cannot meet its burden of proving any of the

Objections: wage violations; Newway avails itself to any substantive defenses offered by Baja; and OLS's

damages and penalties are excessive.

That Newway be dismissed as a respondent and not held liable for any damages or penalties. In Desired the alternative, that liability be limited to the violations actually proven by OLS, but in no case to Relief:

exceed the eight employees actually spoken to by OLS.
