- 5. Rebuttal and 2<sup>nd</sup> Rebuttal Witness and Exhibit Lists. These deadlines no longer apply.
- 6. Office Filings. Unchanged.

While largely received, depending on an interrogatory response, scheduling issues may remain. If the parties cannot resolve them, a motion or pre-hearing conference request may be appropriate.
