During the prehearing conference, the following matters were discussed and agreed¹:

- 1. The Applicant may file a prehearing motion which, shall be filed with the Office of Hearing Examiner and a copy served on the other party <u>no later than</u> 5:00 PM on June 7, 2022.
- 2. The response to any prehearing motion shall be filed and served <u>no later than</u> 5:00 PM on June 21, 2022.
- 3. The reply to any response shall be filed and served <u>no later than 5:00 PM on</u> June 24, 2022.
- 4. Appellant deadline for filing and serving final witness list, final exhibit list, serving other parties an electronic copy of each of the exhibits listed on the exhibit list, and filing with the Office of Hearing Examiner an electronic copy and a hard copy of said exhibits: June 22, 2022.

- 5. Department and Applicant deadline for filing and serving final witness list, final exhibit list, serving other parties an electronic copy of each of the exhibits listed on the exhibit list, and filing with the Office of Hearing Examiner an electronic copy and a hard copy of said exhibits: June 29, 2022.
- 6. Exhibit and witness lists are filed with the Office of Hearing Examiner using the e-file system. Copies of exhibits are filed with the Office of Hearing Examiner in hard copy form and electronic form. Hard copies of exhibits are filed with the Office of Hearing Examiner by mail and must be mailed on the date they are due. Electronic copies of exhibits must be filed with the Office of Hearing Examiner by email at: Hearing Examiner @seattle.gov. Electronic copies of exhibits must be labeled numerically in the order identified in the exhibit list. Each exhibit should be submitted as an individual Word or .pdf document, and each document must be saved with a brief and accurate descriptive title (no more than 1-3 words) to identify the document for other users. Parties are not required to provide copies of an exhibit to another party if the other party is known to possess a copy of the exhibit.
- 7. Final witness lists must include the names of witnesses, a summary of their expected testimony, and an estimate of time that will be dedicated to direct examination of the witness. If a witness will be testifying as an expert, a statement of qualifications must be included with the witness list. Except for purposes of impeachment, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.
- 8. The parties will meet service requirements by electronic service.
- 9. Unless otherwise stated, deadlines are no later than 5:00 PM.
- 10. The hearing in this matter is scheduled to be held on **Wednesday**, **July 6**, **2022**, beginning at **9:00 AM** via remote hearing platform Zoom. In addition to this initial hearing date, July 7 has been reserved on the hearing calendar for continuation of the hearing.
