**I. STIPULATION**

COME NOW the parties, Respondent, the City of Seattle and the Office of Labor Standards, and Appellants, Baja Concrete USA Corp., Newway Forming, Inc., and Antonio Machado, by and through their respective attorneys, and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. This matter is scheduled for an appeal hearing on January 9-12, 17, 18, 2023.
2. The deadline for filing the final witness and exhibits lists is December 12, 2022.
3. The parties have conferred and agree to pursue mediation.
4. The parties are waiting on the mediator to confirm a mediation date in January, 2023.
5. The parties agree that mediation may eliminate the need for a contested hearing.
6. The parties agree that the hearing currently scheduled for January 9-12, 17, 18, 2023 should be temporarily stayed until the parties have completed mediation. In the event the case is not resolved through mediation, the parties will need to consult to establish a new case schedule, including a new schedule for filing final witness and exhibits lists.

7. The parties hope to resolve the matter through mediation. However, in the event that it is not possible to do so, the parties will request a prehearing conference date and time convenient to the Hearing Examiner to set the new contested hearing dates and filing deadlines.
