I. INTRODUCTION

Appellant Jennifer Godfrey submits the following additional witness information to comply with paragraph 11 of the March 6, 2025 Prehearing Order.

II. CONFIRMED WITNESSES

A. Expert Witnesses

Following are the witnesses Appellant Godfrey plans to call as experts. All of the identified expert witnesses have been asked to provide statements of qualifications in the form of a CV or resumé. Only Hoss and Morris have provided a specific document to the undersigned as of this filing. Accessible links and copies of other relevant information regarding their qualifications are provided to fill the gap in information.

David Bain, Ph.D., Orca Conservancy, approximately 1 hour. Dr. Bain will
testify concerning the negative environmental impacts likely to result from the
City's proposed actions—increased housing density and failure to prevent loss

- of urban forest canopy from harming marine life with a focus on the Southern Resident Killer Whale (SRKW) population of Orcas.
- 2. Keith Roraback, Wastewater Technician. Mr. Roraback is more in the nature of a fact witness than an expert: he will testify concerning the operation of the wastewater management and treatment system in Seattle, less than an hour. Mr. Roraback has no LinkedIn page.
- 3. Joshua Morris, Conservation Manager, Birds Connect Seattle, up to two hours. Morris's CV is included. In addition, Mr. Morris submitted extensive comments on the DEIS; his testimony will include his assessment of the adequacy of the City's responses to those comments.
- 4. Theodore Hoss, Urban Forest Canopy Analyst, approximately one hour. Mr. Hoss will testify concerning the accuracy of the City's urban forest canopy analyses. Mr. Hoss has no LinkedIn page.
- 5. Vivek Shandas, Urban Ecologist, up to two hours. Dr. Shandas will testify about the likely impacts from the City's planned actions and the completeness and adequacy of the City's proposed mitigation measures. Dr. Shandas' is not yet in hand; his introduction page at his employer is submitted.
- 6. Water Pollution Analyst TBD, approximately1 hour. This witness will address the pollution to surface waters, both lacustrine and oceanic, resulting from stormwater runoff in Seattle. Appellant Godfrey will provide information on this planned expert witness if retained prior to the April 14 deadline set forth in the pre-hearing order.
- B. Non-expert Witnesses

Appellant plans to call up to three non-expert witnesses to testify about the disjunct between the City's municipal code provisions regarding urban forest canopy—primary SMC Chapter 25.11—and the on-the-ground status of the City's implementation of those provisions. These witnesses will present evidence based on reviews of the City's data, reports, and studies compared to "facts on the ground" to show that Seattle's urban forest canopy is declining in both quantity and quality (shifting from larger conifers to smaller deciduous trees). The identity of these witnesses will be indicated no later than April 14.
