PREHEARING ORDER

June 30, 2015	Expected date of decision on any prehearing motions
July 6, 2015	All parties shall file their complete final witness <sup>1</sup> and exhibit lists with the Office of Hearing Examiner and serve them on all other parties. The parties shall also exchange among themselves copies of the exhibits included on the exhibit lists.

July 22, 2015

Hearing on the merits of the appeal at 9:00 a.m.

<sup>1</sup>Witness lists must include the names of witnesses and a brief summary of their expected testimony. If a witness will be testifying as an expert, a statement of qualifications must be included. Except for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.

The parties are reminded that <u>Hearing Examiner Rule (HER) 2.05(a)</u> requires that any electronically filed document more than 10 pages in length, including exhibits, must also be delivered to the Hearing Examiner in hard copy; and <u>HER 2.05(c)</u> prohibits the filing of more than 15 pages with the Office of Hearing Examiner by electronic facsimile.
