DPD intends to file a motion in limine that may affect the issues on appeal and whether discovery pertaining to those issues is warranted. The schedule may be adjusted on motion of the parties if more time is needed on account of discovery-related issues.

Witness lists shall include the name of each witness who will be testifying at hearing, noting the subject matter and expected duration of each witness's testimony, and whether the witness will be testifying as an expert. Except for purposes of impeachment, only testimony from witnesses identified on the lists, and exhibits identified in the lists, may be offered at hearing.
