FOSS MARITIME'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL WITNESS AND EXHIBIT LIST

Appellant Foss Maritime Company ("Foss") respectfully requests that the Hearing Examiner grant leave allowing Foss and Appellant Port of Seattle to file supplemental witness and exhibit lists, if necessary, on or before July 30, 2015. The deadline set by the Hearing Examiner for Appellants' witness and exhibit lists is July 21, 2015. Both Foss and the Port will file and serve timely lists. Appellant each require additional time, however, to evaluate the need to present additional evidence because discovery is on-going and has not been completed.

On June 2, 2015, Foss served interrogatories and requests for production on DPD. DPD responded to Foss's discovery on July 7, 2015. In its responses, DPD for the first time identified 69 properties in the City that are, or have been, permitted as a "cargo terminal." DPD also produced over 1,000 pages of documents, which Foss is continuing to review and analyze. These discovery responses have led to additional investigation of relevant facts by

On May 15, 2015, Foss also propounded Public Records Act requests to the office of the Mayor, to the City Council, and to DPD, requesting materials regarding the Interpretation and its preparation. The Office of the Mayor provided its response on June 23, 2015; Foss is following up on some materials that appear to have been improperly redacted. DPD has responded but has not clarified if its response is complete. The City Council has responded in part and has stated that its response is incomplete, and that additional materials will be forthcoming on or before July 31, 2015.

Finally, the depositions of DPD employees Andy McKim and Ben Perkowski have been scheduled for Wednesday, July 21, 2015 and Thursday, July 22, 2015, respectively.

DPD's discovery responses contained heretofore withheld information which requires additional time to analyze and investigate. Appellants anticipate that further documents to be produced by City agencies in response to Foss's outstanding Public Records Act requests may be relevant, admissible, and/or may lead to other relevant, admissible evidence. Accordingly, Foss respectfully requests that Foss and the Port be permitted to supplement their respective witness and exhibit lists on or before July 30, 2015.

Nothing in this Motion is intended to preclude Appellants from naming additional witnesses or exhibits in response to the witness and exhibit list to be filed by the City of Seattle and/or the Soundkeeper Intervenors on July 28, 2015.

The Port of Seattle has advised Foss that it joins in this motion. DATED this Zig day of July, 2015.
