#### PREHEARING ORDER

August 16, 2016: Hearing commences at 9:00 a.m.

Please note that under HER 2.05, if an e-filed document exceeds 10 pages, a hard copy of the document must be delivered to the Hearing Examiner. Faxes are limited to 15 pages, unless prior approval is obtained from the Hearing Examiner.

Witness lists shall include the name of each witness who will be testifying at hearing, noting the subject matter and expected duration of each witness's testimony, and whether the witness will be testifying as an expert. Except for purposes of impeachment, only testimony from witnesses identified on the lists, and exhibits identified in the lists, may be offered at hearing.
