PREHEARING ORDER

A prehearing conference was held in this appeal on November 2, 2016. Appellants Lisa Parriott, et al. were represented by Peter Goldman, attorney-at-law and Alex Sidles, Rule 9 Intern. Appellant Seattle Green Spaces Coalition ("SGSC") was represented by Mary Fleck, attorney-at-law. The Applicant, Yueann Wu, was represented by Samuel M. Jacobs and Brandon Gribben, attorneys-at-law. The Director of the Department of Construction and Inspections ("Department"), was represented by Crystal Torres, Land Use Planner, David Graves, Senior Land Use Planner, William K. Mills, Senior Land Use Planner, and Andrew S. McKim, Land Use Planner Supervisor.

SGSC moved for a site visit by the Hearing Examiner, and the motion was granted. The Examiner will visit the site if the appeals move forward. SGSC also moved for a stay to prevent removal of vegetation or soil from the site. The motion was denied for lack of jurisdiction. Counsel for the Applicant confirmed that during the pendency of this administrative appeal, the Applicant will not take any action with respect to the property that is contrary to law.

December 23, 2016	Deadline for the Applicant and Department to file final witness <sup>1</sup> and exhibit lists with the Office of Hearing Examiner and serve a copy
