AMENDED PREHEARING ORDER

On February 23, 2017, a prehearing conference was held regarding this matter. Represented at the conference were the Appellants, Liveable Phinney et. al. ("Appellants"), by Jeffrey M. Eustis, attorney-at-law. The Applicant, Jay Jannette for Johnson Carr, LLC ("Applicant"), was represented by Jessica M. Clawson, attorney-at-law, and Katie Kendall, attorney-at-law. The City of Seattle ("City"), was represented by Patrick Downs, attorney-at-law.

During the prehearing conference the parties discussed a hearing schedule, briefing schedule for pre-hearing motions, identified a schedule for final witness and exhibit lists and exchange of exhibits, and discussed clarification of appeal issues. The following matters were discussed and resolved:

- 1. The parties are engaging in prehearing discovery on their own initiative, and will notify the Hearing Examiner only if necessary.
- 2. The parties agreed to electronic service of materials.
- 3. The Applicant and City anticipate filing a pre-hearing motion. The Applicant and City shall file with the Office of Hearing Examiner, and serve a copy on the other parties, their motion, no later than 5:00 PM on March 17, 2017.
- 4. The Appellants shall file and serve their response to the motion, <u>no later than</u> 5:00 PM on April 6, 2017.
- 5. The Applicant and City shall file and serve their reply, <u>no later than 5:00 PM</u> on April 14, 2017.
- 6. The parties shall file and serve their final witness lists¹ and final exhibit lists, no later than 5:00 PM on April 25, 2017.

¹ Witness lists must include the names of witnesses and a brief summary of their expected testimony. If a witness will be testifying as an expert, a statement of qualifications must be included. Except for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.

7. Each party shall serve the other party a copy of each of the exhibits listed on their respective exhibit lists, <u>no later than 5:00 PM on April 25, 2017</u>. (Exhibits are <u>not</u> to be filed with the Office of the Hearing Examiner electronically or in hard copy. Parties are not required to provide copies of an exhibit to another party if the other party is known to possess a copy of the exhibit.)

The hearing in this matter is scheduled to be held on <u>May 2, 2017</u>, beginning at 9 a.m. in the Office of Hearing Examiner, Hearing Room 4000, 700 Fifth Avenue, (Seattle Municipal Tower, 40^{th} Floor) Seattle, Washington. In addition to this initial hearing date, **May 3 and 4** have been reserved on the hearing calendar for continuation of the hearing.

The parties are reminded that <u>Hearing Examiner Rule (HER) 2.05(a)</u> requires that any electronically filed document more than 10 pages in length, including exhibits, must also be delivered to the Hearing Examiner in hard copy; and <u>HER 2.05(c)</u> prohibits the filing of more than 15 pages with the Office of Hearing Examiner by electronic facsimile.
