- 3. The existing building (SAAM) does not assert itself into our business of enjoying the gardens and park's natural feel as much as the new structure would. With the new structure, we would have less space and a huge glass wall lording over us. Our ability to enjoy the park will be significantly reduced if this project is built.
- 4. I value parks and open space. I value museums. But open space is far more precious in our increasingly urban environment and our elected officials need to understand how important green park land is. We should be able to enjoy parks, for taking in nature, a breath of fresh air, beauty, without concern for the next time the art museum thinks it needs to add on. This is not their land. It is the public's land. We want to continue to use it and enjoy it without the damage such an expansion would cause to the surrounding trees, and to the calm and natural feel of this place.
