<sup>1</sup>Witness lists must include the names of witnesses a brief summary of their expected testimony, and the approximate amount of time their testimony is expected to take. If a witness will be testifying as an expert, a statement of qualifications must be included. Except for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.

<u>Note</u>: If the parties reach agreement on different deadlines for filing and serving final witness and exhibit lists, the parties' written stipulation on the matter shall supersede the applicable provisions of this order.
