DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION:

All businesses engaging in marijuana business in the City of Seattle are required to possess a valid Seattle Title 6 marijuana regulatory license issued by the Seattle Department of Finance and Administrative Services (FAS), in addition to any other license or permit including a Washington State issued marijuana license.

Seattle Events A Nonprofit Corp DBA Hempfest Central or Seattle Hempfest, hosted an event at 120 N 35th St. and is engaged as a marijuana business in Seattle and does not have a Seattle issued Title 6 marijuana license. See Declaration of Tim Guice. Seattle Events A NonProfit Corp does not hold a Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board marijuana license. "Marijuana business" means any person or entity that grows, possesses, produces, processes, manufactures, sells (whether at wholesale or retail), distributes, transports, allows for consumption on their premises, or delivers marijuana with the object of gain, benefit, or advantage to the person, and includes, but is not limited to, any marijuana processor, producer, or retailer, regardless of whether the marijuana is intended for medical or recreational use. (SMC 6.500.020)
