Re: Participation in UW CMP Prehearing Conference

Dear Mr. West,

Thank you for your e-mail message of October 26, 2017. The University of Washington's application for a new major institution master plan ("MIMP") comes before the Hearing Examiner pursuant to SMC 23.69.032.H, SMC 23.76.052, and the Hearing Examiner Rules of Practice and Procedure, which are available on the Hearing Examiner's web page, www.seattle.gov/examiner/. In this case, the SEPA process was completed by the University of Washington, so there will be no SEPA appeals included in the case before the Hearing Examiner. It will be limited to consideration of the MIMP application itself.

The parties to a case in which the Hearing Examiner considers a MIMP application are limited to the applicant; SDCI, which issues the Director's report and recommendation on the application; and the Department of Neighborhoods as the coordinator for the Citizens Advisory Committee. The parties received notice from this office concerning the prehearing conference to be held in the case, and will receive any further notices sent out from this office. Both the prehearing conference and the hearing on the MIMP are now included on the calendar of case activity available on the Hearing Examiner's web page. When SDCI issues its report and recommendation on the MIMP, it will include public notice of the availability of the report and of the hearing in the Land Use Bulletin.



There is no opportunity for public testimony at a prehearing conference, but members of the public may attend and observe the conference.
