ORDER ON THE
CITY'S MOTION TO
EXTEND DEADLINES

The City of Seattle ("City") filed a Motion Extend Deadlines for Depositions and Pre-hearing motions in this matter on April 18, 2019. The Hearing Examiner set the deadline for responses to the City's Motion for April 23, 2018. No responses to the City's motion were received.

HER 2.16 (b) provides:

Within 7 days after service of a written motion, or such other time as may be designated by the Hearing Examiner, any other party may file a written response. After the Hearing Examiner has received any written responses, or the 7 days or other designated time has elapsed, the Hearing Examiner may rule on the motion. Failure of a party to file a timely response may be considered by the Hearing Examiner as evidence of that party's consent to the motion.

As no party has responded to the City's motion, the motion is **GRANTED**, and the deadline for completion of depositions, and for filing motions *in limine* is extended to May 31, 2018. All other dates and instructions remain as identified in the February 16, 2018 prehearing order.

Due to the extensive nature of discovery identified in the motion, and in comments submitted with the parties' witness and exhibit, and to the volume of witnesses and exhibits identified in the same lists, there is adequate information in the record to indicate the reasonable likelihood of needing additional time for the hearing beyond what has already by scheduled. The Hearing Examiner requests party representatives to not schedule activities that would compromise their ability to attend an extended hearing in August, or to be prepared with an alternate representative. If additional hearing dates are identified they will only be scheduled sometime between August 13 and 31, and there will be a strong emphasis made to try to schedule any such extension during the week of August 20-24. No determination as to additional hearing dates will made until the June 11<sup>th</sup> prehearing conference.
