APPLICANT'S REPLY IN FURTHER SUPPORT OF MOTION TO DISMISS LAND USE APPEAL

On May 8, 2018, Examiner Ehrlichman issued a Prehearing Order¹ that directed SDCI and the applicant, Blueprint Capital Services ("Blueprint"), to file any dispositive motions by May 11, 2018. On May 11, 2018, Blueprint filed a motion to dismiss the land use appeal because, among other things, (a) the Project is not required to provide any parking because it is located within 1,320 feet of frequent transit, and (b) the Hearing Examiner does not have jurisdiction to require the Project to provide additional parking. SDCI also submitted a motion to dismiss raising similar issues. The Prehearing Order required the Appellant to file a response to the motion "no later than 5:00 PM on May 18, 2018." The Appellant failed to file a response to the motions to dismiss and has not otherwise opposed the motions. Thus, for the reasons stated in Blueprint's and SDCI's motions to dismiss, the Hearing Examiner should dismiss the land use appeal with prejudice.

PREHEARING ORDER

Except for purposes of impeachment or rebuttal, only those witnesses and exhibits listed by the parties may be offered at the hearing.

7. Each party shall serve the other parties a copy of each of the exhibits listed on their exhibit lists, no later than 5:00 PM on May 30, 2018. (Exhibits are not to be filed with the Office of the Hearing Examiner electronically or in hard copy. Parties are not required to provide copies of an exhibit to another party if the other party is known to possess a copy of the exhibit. Parties must be prepared to provide a copy of any exhibit to be introduced at the hearing in hard-copy form to the Hearing Examiner.)
