Thank you for your letter dated October 11, 2016. In response, the Greenwood Parcel 9468200032 in Seattle, Washington has been added to the Superfund Enterprise Management System database. SEMS is a database used by the Federal Superfund Program to track potential hazardous waste site information.

A preliminary assessment (PA) of the Greenwood Parcel 9468200032 will be completed within one year. A PA is a limited-scope investigation that involves the collection and review of readily available information about the site and its surrounding area. The PA is designed to distinguish, based on limited data, between sites that pose little or no threat to human health and the environment and sites that may pose a threat and require further investigation. If the PA results in a recommendation for further investigation, an additional level of information collection, called a site investigation, is generally performed.
